The Arts & Cultural Council for Greater Rochester is seeking nominations for its 19th Annual Arts Awards. The Awards will be presented at a luncheon on **Thursday, October 31, 2002**, at the Rochester Riverside Convention Center. Save the Date!

### Award Categories

You are invited to submit one or more nominations in the following categories:

- **Business/ Foundation:** A business or foundation that has provided significant support to the arts and cultural life in the Rochester region.
- **Cultural Organization:** An organization that has made an outstanding contribution to the arts and cultural life of our community.
- **Individual:** An individual who has made a significant contribution to the arts in our community through arts in education, patronage, development of cultural programming, or arts activism.
- **Literary Artist:** A literary artist, residing in the Rochester region, who has made a significant contribution to the art form in our community.
- **Media Artist:** A film, video or electronic media artist, residing in the Rochester region, who has made a significant contribution to the art form in our community.
- **Performing Artist:** A performing artist, residing in the Rochester region, who has made a significant contribution to the art form in our community.
- **Visual Artist:** A visual artist, residing in the Rochester region, who has made a significant contribution to the art form in our community.

### Cultural Organization Anniversaries

The Arts Council will recognize significant anniversaries at the Arts Awards Luncheon. Anniversaries (in five-year intervals) of cultural organizations in continuous operation for at least 15 years will be recognized (15 years, 20 years, 25 years, etc.). This is not a competitive category. Please provide:

- Organization Name
- Contact Person
- Address
- Daytime Telephone, Fax, E-mail
- Year founded
- Brief description of the organization's current purpose and activities including specific and overall contributions and impact on the community

### How To Make A Nomination

Send the Arts Council a letter. Please include all of the following:

- For both Nominator and Nominee, please provide:
  - Name
  - Address
  - Daytime Telephone, Fax, E-mail
- Category in which nomination is being made.
- Describe the nominee's specific and overall qualifications. You may wish to include:
  - Number of years of service to the arts in greater Rochester
  - Specific and overall contributions and impact on the community
  - Constituencies served.
- For individuals, please include a resume.
- For organizations, please include the name of a contact person and the organization's mission statement. Briefly describe the organization's current purpose and activities.
- For all nominations: a limited number of support materials is welcome (news clips, brochures).
