The *Fiber Arts Program*, provides funding for projects that advance and promote quilting and other fiber arts, including the creation of new work, educational programming, and documentation of fiber arts techniques.

Artists in Cayuga, Genesee, Livingston, Monroe, Ontario, Orleans, Seneca, Wayne, Wyoming, and Yates Counties, are eligible to apply for a maximum of \$500 to support projects to be completed in 2010. **The deadline for this grant is December 4, 2009.**
