**An Evening with Joseph Sorrentino**  
**A Presentation About Coffee Growers in Mexico's Juarez Mountains**

In November 2003, Joseph Sorrentino traveled to remote villages in the Juarez Mountains of southern Mexico to record the lives of coffee growers. The people he stayed with grow some of the best coffee in the world yet the growers typically earn less than \$2 a day and live in dire poverty. Sorrentino heard a common refrain when interviewing villagers about their lives: "Nosotros sufrimos mucho." We suffer much. On Wednesday, September 17<sup>th</sup>, he will give a presentation about what he found there.
