Rochester, NY, December 23, 2008 – The Arts & Cultural Council for Greater Rochester, in partnership with the New York Foundation for the Arts, will be awarding Strategic Opportunity Stipends (SOS) to artists for work occurring between March and June 2009 that will significantly enhance their careers. Applications for the next SOS round are due to the Arts & Cultural Council by 5 p.m. on Thursday, February 5, 2009.

SOS grants are designed to help individual artists of all disciplines take advantage of unique opportunities that may significantly benefit their work or career development. Visual, literary, media and performing artists may request support ranging from \$100 to \$600 for specific forthcoming opportunities.

Artists from the following 10 counties may apply to the Arts & Cultural Council for Greater Rochester: Cayuga, Genesee, Livingston, Monroe, Ontario, Orleans, Seneca, Wayne, Wyoming and Yates.
